Country Music Jamboree

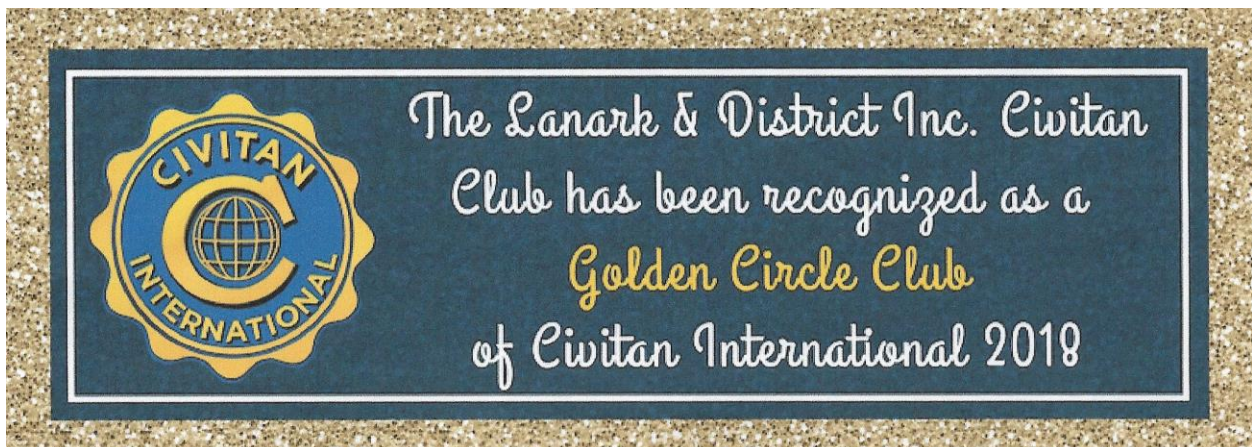
Sunday February 10, 2019

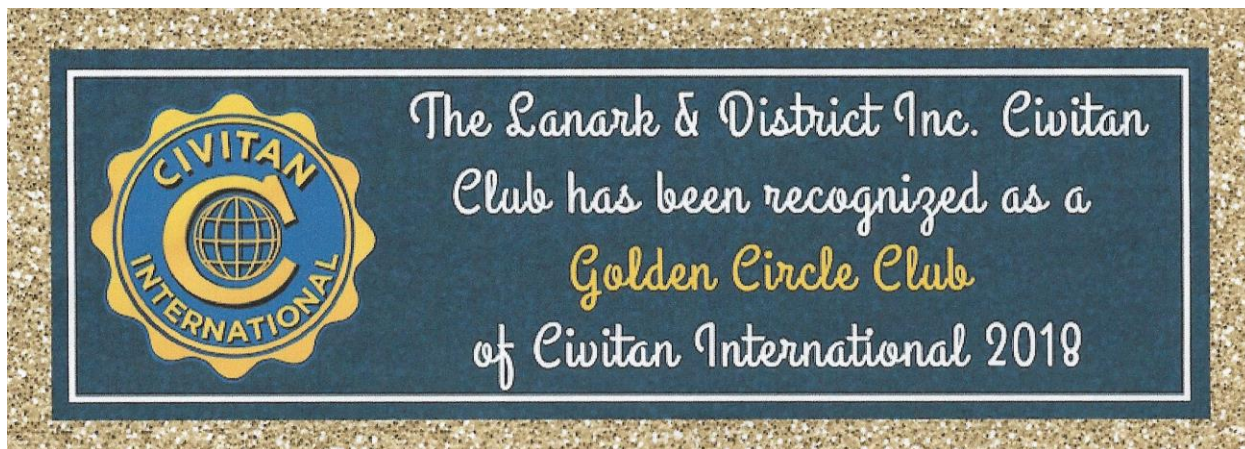
